INTRODUCTION

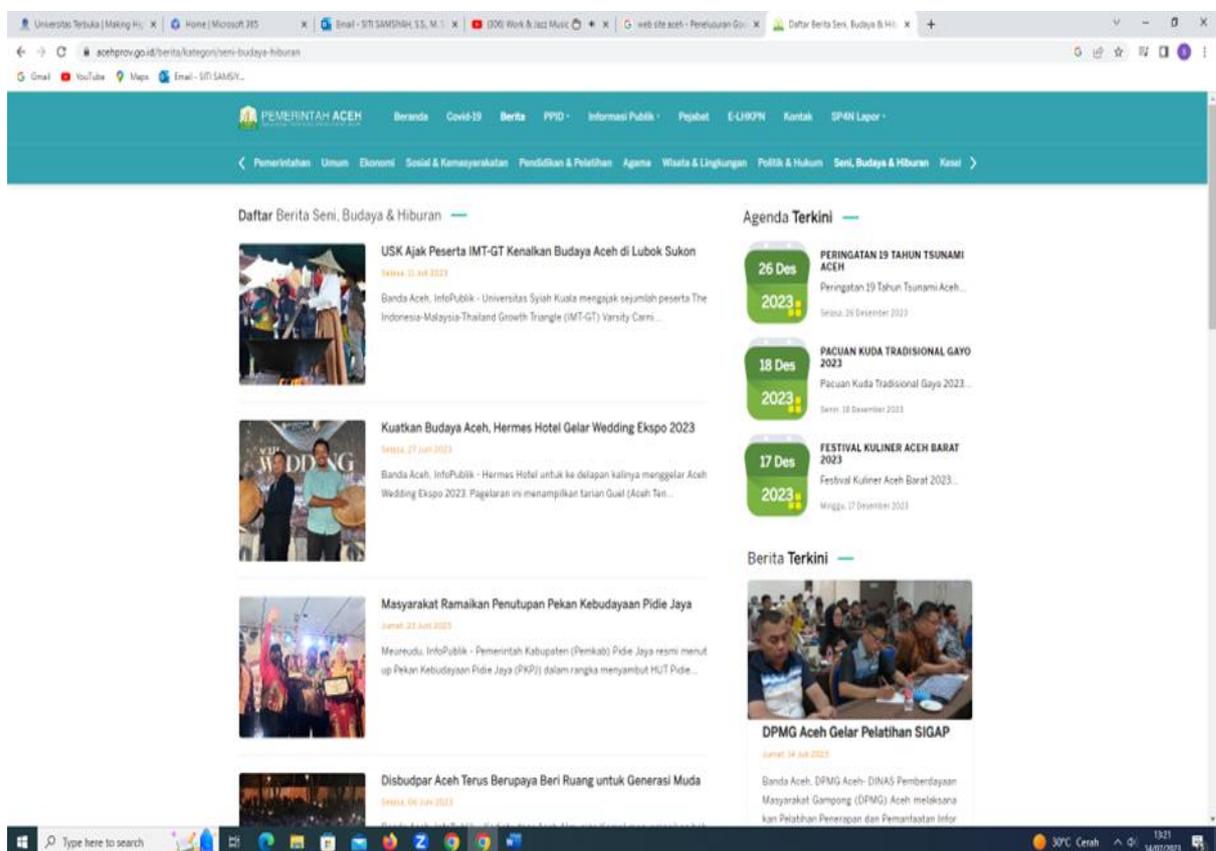

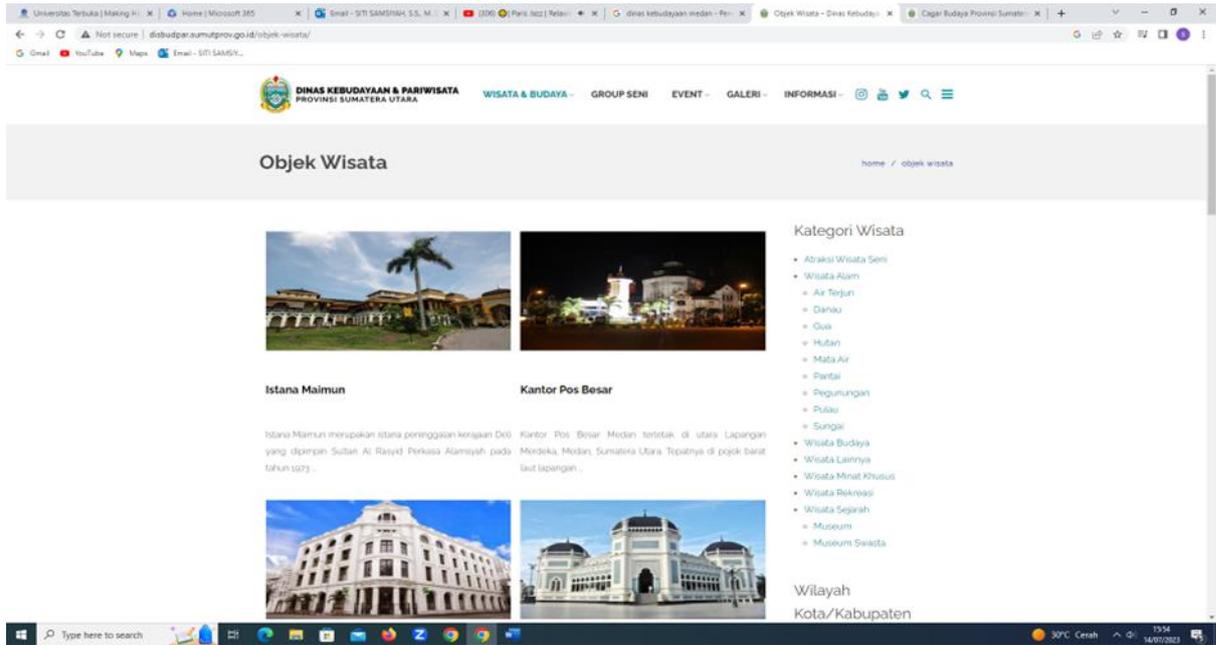
1. Aceh

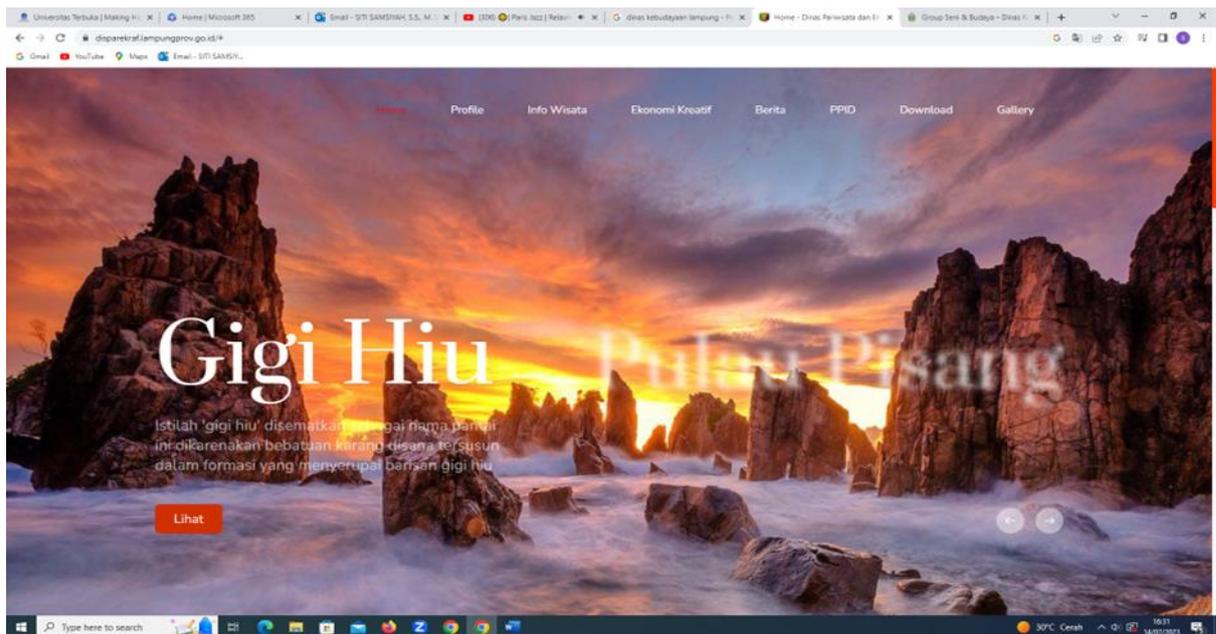
2. Sumatera Utara

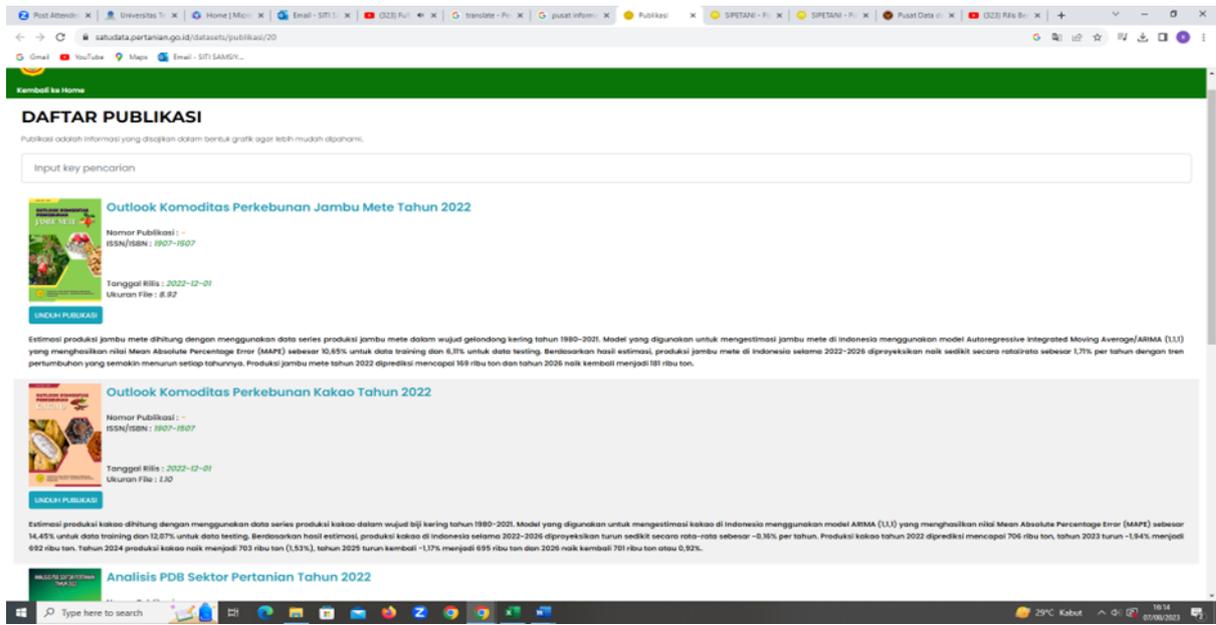

- a) Banjarmasin silver and gold crafts are famous for their silver and gold crafts in the form of rings, bracelets, necklaces and other accessories.
- b) Sasirangan cloth. Sasirangan is a Banjarmasin patterned cloth with various colors. Just like batik, sasirangan also has many unique patterns, such as Iris Shoulder, Sari Gading, and Toadstool Karikit.
- c) Stone crafts. Stone handicrafts are an iconic product of South Kalimantan, this type of handicraft is popular in the people of Kalimantan as well as throughout Indonesia.
- d) Rattan basket. Rattan baskets are one of the handicraft products of South Kalimantan which are usually crowded before holidays. This is because rattan baskets are often used as a place for parcel gifts. Many rattan and bamboo woven products in Banjarmasin are produced by craftsmen from Kapuas Hulu. Many rattan basket craftsmen run their business as a hereditary family business.

2. Crafts in the Palembang region. Some typical Palembang handicrafts.

- a) Palembang Songket Weaving. Palembang Songket weaving/sewet is a traditional craft typical of Palembang and generally this is a home industry. Songket is a woven fabric made with the technique of adding weft threads as decoration, by inserting silver, gold or colored threads on top of the warp threads.
- b) Jump cloth. This cloth is made of silk. The cloth is usually used for traditional Palembang events and other official events.
- c) Tajung cloth. Tajung or Sewet Tajung cloth is a cloth specifically worn for men. The use of this cloth adds to the beauty when the man wears a cauldron or a suit. This cloth is usually made of woven silk cloth with attractive motifs

and colors.

3. Balinese crafts

- a) Sculpture and Painting. In Bali, each region has its own sculptural characteristics, which is why sculptural art in Bali has a variety of techniques and forms.
- b) Silver jewelry. Bali is one of the areas that produce famous silver jewelry. With the ability to beautifully carve, which is passed down through the family line, Balinese jewelry is known to be very strong in its design.
- c) Textile crafts. Like other regions in Indonesia, Bali also has a cultural heritage in the form of Balinese fabrics that have distinctive patterns and colors. Like batik, which is the main textile commodity for people in the Java region.

In addition to the three areas mentioned above, there are still many superior cultural elements found in various regions in Indonesia.
